Dark Gray scrubs (top and bottom) are required for all Health Academy students.

Language Arts Classes - All

Three-ring notebook binder, 2-3 inch spine, with pockets in the inside cover.
Three-ring notebook binder for 9th grade *Grammar*, 2 inch spine, with pockets in the inside cover
A package of 5 dividers
College ruled loose-leaf notebook paper – (no spiral notebooks)
Blue or black pen for writing drafts
Red or green pen for editing
Colored pencils
#2 pencils
Highlighters (4 different colors: yellow, green, pink and blue required)
Ream of white printer/copy paper
USB-Flash Drive/memory storage device (2GB+; used for all Health Academy classes)*
Ear buds/headphones (wired)
Index cards (any size) optional
Pueblo City/County Library Card

Math Classes – All

Graphing Calculator : TI-83, TI-84, or TI-nspire (non CAS) *preferred* *
Compass, Protractor (clear plastic is best), & Ruler
Colored pencils
Pad of graph paper
Loose-leaf paper, college ruled please
2-pocket folder
Pen (1 red, 1 black)
Pencil case
Spiral-bound note pad (3" x 5")

Whitefield- 2 composition books (graphing preferred) and glue sticks for entire year (or tape)

12th Grade Chemistry 2

Calculator (See math classes)--no cell phones
Black or blue pens
Pencils (preferably mechanical)
Graph paper
Loose-leaf notebook paper, college ruled, **no spirals**
2-3" 3 Ring Binder
Binder Dividers with pockets
5 packages of 3" x 5" index cards
5 packages of large post-it notes
2 Composition books

All students by grade level:

9th Grade Biology 1 students – 4 rolls of paper towels, 1 pump bottle of hand soap, 1 box of nitrile gloves (100 count)
10th Graders –1 box of nitrile gloves (your size, minimum of 100 count), 4 rolls of paper towels, 1 ream of paper, 1 container of Clorox wipes
11th Grade Anatomy students – 4 rolls of paper towels, 1 container of Clorox wipes, 1 box of nitrile gloves (100 count)
12th Graders – 4 rolls of paper towels, 1 box of nitrile gloves (your size, minimum of 100 count), 1 ream of paper, 1 container of Clorox wipes

*Note: The TI-83+ and the TI-nspire (non CAS) are the best calculators for all the higher level math courses and purchasing it during the freshman year puts students at an advantage for later years. It is more expensive than most, but can be used for other classes as well. It is also acceptable for use on the ACT. Casio, TI-85, TI-89, and TI-nspire w/ CAS graphing calculators are **not** recommended.

There are frequently great sales on all calculators and USB Flashdrive memory storage devices (2GB+) just before school starts.
